

COMPONENTS OF PROTECTIVE SECURITY

Security Governance

The process of establishing and maintaining organisational adherence to policies and internal controls through the development of a framework that informs security strategies and measures that are aligned with and support business objectives, and consistent with applicable state and federal laws.



Physical Security

The provision and maintenance of a safe and secure environment for the protection of employees and clients as well as physical measures designed to prevent unauthorised access to confidential and sensitive resources and to detect and respond to intruders.



Information and Cyber Security

All measures used to protect business, client and personal information from compromise, loss of integrity or unavailability.

This includes to protection of stored data and information, documents, and computer devices.



Personnel Security

The management of personnel to assist in the protection of people, information and assets; including personal and family based protection, initial and ongoing staff screening, and education and evaluation of personnel (staff and contractors etc).
